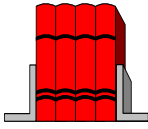


# How to help at home Year 4... Term Summer

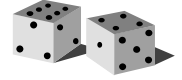


## Literacy

Read at least three times weekly. Discuss/ ask questions about text. Look at writing in other places as well such as magazines, letters and newspapers.

## Mathematics

Help your child to learn the times tables. Involve your child in daily activities such as shopping, telling the time and measuring.

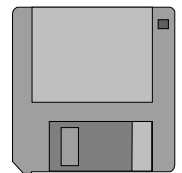


## Science

Discuss your child's science lesson, what have they learnt? Encourage children to look at plants and flowers in gardens, parks etc. What do they notice when they look closely? What are the differences and similarities between plants?

## I.C.T.

If you have access to the internet encourage your child to research facts about topics they are doing in other subjects. Use computers occasionally to present written homework or to download relevant pictures.



## P.E.

Encourage your child to practise bat and ball skills.  
Ensure correct footwear and kit is available for comfort and for injury prevention.

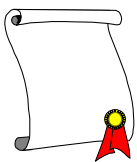


## History
