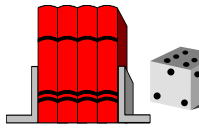


How to help at home Year 6 Summer Term

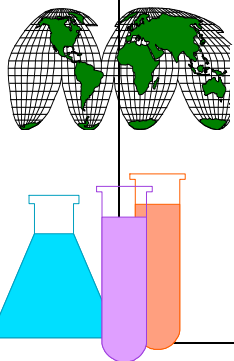
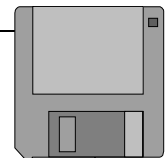


English & Maths

- Ensure children get plenty of rest and sleep in the week leading to SATs, and are in school promptly all week

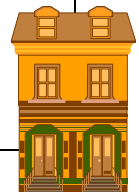
Topic & Other Subjects



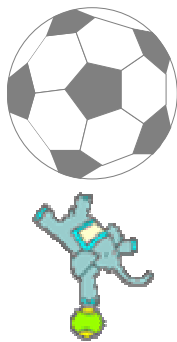
In science we will be looking at the natural world, and how animals are classified and how they adapt to live in different environments, along with foods chains and Microorganisms.
