

Home learning 	You should read as often as possible with your child. Please complete the reading record when your child reads with you, the record is a form of dialogue between the school and home. You might also receive additional homework tasks that will further support their learning in phonics. By reading to your child several times a week, they will have access to literature beyond their reading age, which will develop their knowledge and vocabulary, improving their reading comprehension.
Website 	The class page, which is accessible via the school website, will be updated regularly. We will also provide information to help you support your child with learning at home
PE 	Our P.E. lessons this term will be on Tuesday afternoons. Please can you ensure that your child's PE kit remains in school throughout the week and that all items of your child's kit are named. Any earrings must be removed for PE and long hair needs to be tied back.
Library	Our new library will be available for children to use. Year 1 will be visiting the library every Thursday afternoon.
Class Charters and Rewards 	Each class starts the year by creating their Class Charter, which form the class rules that each child agreed to follow. House points will be awarded to children who follow the school values by showing polite manners, positive teamwork or excellent effort. Celebration assemblies are held every Friday, where children may receive a certificate for being the Star of the Week or Mathematician of the Week.
