
Home learning



Each week your child should:

- read aloud regularly (daily if possible)
- practise the weekly spellings daily (using the honeycomb strategies provided and spelling shed)
- practise times tables (via Times Table Rockstars)
- Complete a weekly home learning task delivered via the Edmodo platform

In addition, the most important thing you can do is to continue to read **to** your child throughout primary school. By reading to your child several times a week, they will have access to literature beyond their reading age, which will develop their knowledge and vocabulary, improving their reading comprehension. Reading a page each is a great way to engage with a child and to spend some quality time together.
