Home learning



Reading – Children should read aloud regularly (daily if possible). In addition, the most important thing you can do is to continue to read to your child. By reading to your child several times a week, they will have access to literature beyond their reading age, which will develop their knowledge and vocabulary, improving their reading comprehension.

Spelling – Children will be given a spelling rule and words to learn each week. These words will be given on a Friday and then tested the following Friday. To practise the weekly spellings children can use Spelling Shed and the honeycomb strategies provided.

Times tables – Children should practise times tables via Times Table Rockstars or using any other strategy.

Maths – Children will be given a short maths task to complete each week to either rehearse the skills learnt in school or to prepare them for an up and coming topic. This will be set on a Tuesday and will need to be completed by the following Tuesday

English – Children will be given a short comprehension or grammar task. This will be set on a Tuesday and will need to be completed by the following Tuesday
