Home learning



Each week your child should: read aloud regularly (daily if possible); practise the weekly spellings daily (using the honeycomb strategies provided and Spelling Shed) and practise times tables (via Times Table Rockstars). In addition, the most important thing you can do is to continue to read to your child throughout primary school. By reading to your child several times a week, they will have access to literature beyond their reading age, which will develop their knowledge and vocabulary, improving their reading comprehension. Reading a page each is a great way to engage with a text together.

Outdoor Learning

Class Charters & Rewards
