Home learning



Each week your child should: read aloud regularly (daily if possible); practise their weekly spellings daily (using the honeycomb strategies provided) and practise times tables (2, 5 and 10, via Times Table Rockstars). In addition, the most important thing you can do is to continue to read to your child throughout primary school. By reading to your child several times a week, they will have access to literature beyond their reading age, which will develop their knowledge and vocabulary, improving their reading comprehension.

P.E.



Our P.E. lessons this term will be on Tuesday and Wednesday afternoons. Please can you ensure that your child's P.E. kit remains in school throughout the week and that all items of your child's kit are named.
