### Home learning



You should read as often as possible with your child. Please complete the reading record when your child reads with you, the record is a form of dialogue between the school and home. You might also receive additional homework tasks that will further support their learning in phonics.

By reading to your child several times a week, they will have access to literature beyond their reading age, which will develop their knowledge and vocabulary, improving their reading comprehension.

Your child will start to take spellings to learn at home. Spellings will be tested in class on a **Thursday** and they will be given new spellings to learn for that week. We will take the spelling books in on a Wednesday to put the new spellings in. Please make sure your child has their spelling book in school everyday as we practise them in school as well.
