Home learning



Reading: You should read as often as possible with your child. Please complete the reading record when your child reads with you, the record is a form of dialogue between the school and home. You will also receive additional homework tasks that will further support their learning in phonics.

By reading to your child several times a week, they will have access to literature beyond their reading age, which will develop their knowledge and vocabulary, improving their reading comprehension.

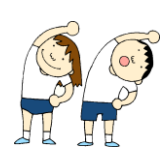
