

This term, in Badger class, our topic is

Journeys and Maps



Our PE days are Tuesdays and Fridays.

Key vocabulary:

Science- exercise, hygiene, nutrition, diet

Art- Colour, Pattern, Shape,

Geography - Scotland, England, Northern island, Wales, London, Cardiff, Belfast, Edinburgh, location, key, road, motorway, river,

Computing- algorithm, instructions, timer, collusion detection, design mode, sequence

English

We will be sharing a range of texts including 'The three little wolves and the big bad pig,' 'King Midas' and 'Meerkat mail'

We will continue to teach the use of finger spaces, full stops, capital letters and question marks. We will encourage children to write expanded noun phrases (adding more detail to the noun by adding one or more adjectives for example the large, royal castle).

This term we will introduce guided reading sessions. As a whole class, the children will be introduced to a story and they will develop their reading strategies. We will then answer questions about the text.

Maths

This term we will be looking at money and multiplication and division. Please help your child by playing 'shops' You could ask them to make a certain amount for example £2.20. This will help your child to recognise the coins.

Foundation subjects:

As **scientists**, we will be:

- Able to describe the importance for humans of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of food, and hygiene.
- Perform simple tests.

As **musicians**, we will be:

Using the theme of Toys as inspiration, they will be learning to perform on tuned instruments, developing their ability to perform together as an ensemble from dot notation.

As **artists**, we will be:

- Learn about and experiment with colour mixing and cool and warm colours.
- Research information about Georgia O'Keefe and discover how she used colour in her art
- Recreate their own art in the style of Georgia O'Keefe

As **geographers** we will be:

- use world maps, atlases and globes to identify the United Kingdom and its countries
- name, locate and identify characteristics of the four countries and capital cities of the United Kingdom and its surrounding seas

PSHE

In PSHE this term our theme is 'Dreams and goals'

P.E.

In PE we will be doing yoga and playing invasion games.

R.E.

We will be learning about Islam and answering the question: Does praying at regular intervals help a Muslim in his/her everyday life?
