<u>English</u>

We will be sharing lots of stories including Ravi's Roar and Bog Baby. We will also create our own non-fiction text about animals found on Wildmoor Heath.

We will continue to teach the use of finger spaces, full stops, capital letters and question marks. We will encourage children to use interesting adjectives (describing words) and write in different tenses.

<u>Maths</u>

This term we will be looking at Place Value (up to 100) and addition and subtraction. We will be continuing to develop the children's understanding of numbers up to 100. Our focus will be number bonds (two numbers that add together) to 10, then 20 and then to 100.

Foundation subjects:

As scientists, we will be:

- Exploring and comparing the differences between things that are living, dead, and things that have never been alive
- identifying and naming a variety of plants and animals in their habitats, including microhabitats
- identifying what a habitat is
- describing a simple food chain

As musicians, we will be:

- Listen, learn and respond to new songs.
- Compose and perform a new song.

As **artists**, we will be:

- Designing and creating our own clay tile based on the painting 'Surprised' by Henri Rousseau
- Use techniques such as rolling, cutting, moulding and carving

As geographers we will be:

- Study our school and its grounds
- Exploring the school and its local environment

<u>PSHE</u>

In PSHE this term our theme is 'Being me in my world'

<u>P.E.</u>

In Outdoor PE we will continue to focus on ball skills. In Indoor PE we will develop the fundamental skills of balancing, running, changing direction, jumping, hopping and skipping.

<u>R.E.</u>

We will be learning about Christianity and focussing on the question 'What does Jesus teach?'
