Here is an overview of what we are learning in Year One this term:

Literacy

We will be reading and sharing many books for this half-term including 'Superworm', 'Oi! Frog' and 'Here comes Mr Postman'. We will be also looking at non-fiction books to learn about different jobs such as firefighters, doctors and chefs.

Our writing will be focussing on writing a character description, writing a letter and composing our own funny poem. When writing, children will be encouraged to use a correct pencil grip and form their letters correctly in preparation for joining their letters. We will teach the use of finger spaces, full stops and capital letters in addition to a range of adjectives and conjunctions such as 'and'.

Maths

This term we will be looking at addition and subtraction and place value within 50. Our focus will be on accurate counting, writing numerals and counting on.

Help your child by finding two numbers that make 20. Can they collect the correct number of objects? For example, 10 pencils and another 10 make 20.

Foundation subjects

As **scientists** we'll be:

- Exploring the season of Winter
- Naming the parts of the body
- Discovering the five senses

As artists we'll be:

- Creating a portrait of ourselves to show the things that we do
- Creating an ID card

As **geographers** we'll be finding out:

- About the services and buildings in Crowthorne
- How to create our own street map

As **musicians**, we'll be finding out:

 How to use our voices expressively and creatively in saying chants and rhymes

As **designers**, we'll be finding out:

How to plan a healthy snack for one of our characters

PSHE

In PSHE this term we will be focussing on dreams and goals.
