Here is an overview of what we are learning in Year One this term:

### **Literacy**

We will be sharing lots of stories associated with weather. We will focus on nursery rhymes and share the story 'After the Storm'. We will also retell the story of 'Jack and the Beanstalk'.

When writing, children will be encouraged to use a correct pencil grip and form their letters correctly in preparation for joining their letters together. We will teach the use of finger spaces, full stops and capital letters.

### **Maths**

This term we will be looking at place value (within 10), followed by an introduction to addition and subtraction. We will be continuing to develop the children's understanding of numbers and will be finding different ways of making numbers to 10. Our focus will be on accurate counting, writing numerals, grouping and counting on.

## **Foundation subjects**

**As scientists**, we will be:

- Observe changes across the four seasons and focus on the season of Autumn.
- observe and describe weather associated with the seasons
- identify and name a variety of common wild and garden plants, including deciduous and evergreen trees

**As musicians**, we will be:

- Finding the pulse and the rhythm of a piece of music.
- Composing a simple melody

**As artists**, we will be:

- Looking at sunflower art (Van Gogh)
- Use some of the ideas from Van Gogh to create pieces
- Making a collage from natural objects we have collected from our seasonal walk

As **geographers** we will be:

- identifying seasonal and daily weather patterns in the United Kingdom.

### **PSHE-'Being Me in My World**

In PSHE this term we will be looking at class rules and learning about feelings, helping and working with others.

### **P.E.**

This term in outdoor PE we will focus on ball skills.

### **R.E.**

We will be learning about Christianity and the creation story.

### **ICT & Computing**

We'll be finding out about:

- Logging on and off
- Using a computer safely
- Accessing the internet
