Home learning



Reading: Each week your child should: read aloud regularly (daily if possible). In addition, the most important thing you can do is to continue to read to your child throughout primary school. By reading with your child several times a week, they will have access to literature beyond their reading age, which will develop their knowledge and vocabulary, improving their reading comprehension. Reading a page each is a great way to engage with a text together.

Spelling: Children are given weekly spellings to learn on a Friday and are then tested the following Friday. Children should practise these spellings daily using Spelling Shed.

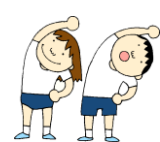
Times Tables: Children should be practising times tables and division facts every day using Times Table Rockstars.

Class Charters & Rewards
