Home learning



Reading: Children should read aloud regularly (daily if possible). In addition, the most important thing you can do is to continue to read to your child. By reading to your child several times a week, they will have access to literature beyond their reading age, which will develop their knowledge and vocabulary, improving their reading comprehension.

Spelling: Children will be given a spelling pattern and words to learn each week. These words will be given on a Monday and then tested the following Monday. To practise the weekly spellings children can use Spelling Shed and the honeycomb strategies provided in the spelling home learning books.

Times tables: Children should practise times tables via Times Table Rockstars or by using any other strategy. They need to be know their multiplication and division facts for speed and accuracy.

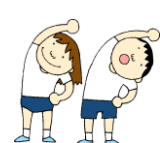
Maths or Writing: Children will be given either a short maths task to complete each week to either rehearse the skills learnt in school or a short grammar/writing task. This will be set on a Thursday and will need to be completed by the following Tuesday.

Class Charters and Rewards



Each class start the year by creating their Class Charter, which form the class rules that each child agree to follow.
