## INTENT

Coupled with these skills and areas of knowledge, we ensure that all learners have a secure understanding of how to stay safe online, recognise positive or harmful online relationships and report any concerns with confidence. Staying safe online is linked to our Relationships and Health Education (RHE) curriculum where the learning is layered across the entire Wildmoor curriculum, including:

## IMPLEMENTATION

We implement our computing curriculum in a carefully mapped, sequence and progressive way, using the Purple Mash scheme of work, focusing on Computer Science, Digital Literacy and Information Technology. We ensure that learners are well prepared for transition to secondary school where it is essential that they have a strong command of various applications to access the full secondary curriculum and make optimal progress.
