Due to the CV-19 pandemic, we are continuing to exercise extreme caution over the number of adults and visitors coming into school. To protect the health and safety of all parties, we will not hold the autumn Parent Teacher Meetings – instead, we will issue Pupil Summary sheets for each child. Teachers will discuss how well your child has settled back into school routines, their learning behaviours and their personal targets for this term. The Pupil Summary sheets will be issued in early November 2020. Should you wish to discuss your child's summary with the class teacher at that time, please contact the teacher via the class e-mail.

Remote Learning

We are all too aware that, in the current environment, regular testing and self-isolation periods are becoming the norm. Should your child need to self-isolate, but is not ill, it is very important that he/she accesses their learning at home to ensure continued academic progress throughout the year. Wildmoor class teachers will provide the class learning remotely via our learning platform, Edmodo.
