I am writing to inform you that Mr. Thomas, our Deputy Headteacher has been offered a leadership position as Head of School within the local area, from April 2022. Mr. Thomas will hence leave Wildmoor Heath at the end of the spring term and I wish to share our plans with you for continuity of provision and leadership.

I would like to reassure all our parents and carers that we have already started the process to recruit a strong replacement Deputy Headteacher and to ensure that our leadership team remains a strong core at the heart of our school.
