I am not sure if I should send my child to school...

Do they have ANY of the following:

1. a high temperature;
2. a new and continuous cough;
3. a loss, or, change to your sense of smell or taste?

Yes

- ❖ Your child **CANNOT** come to school unless they have a negative test.
- ❖ No test done – your child **CANNOT** come to school and must self-isolate for 10 days, and family members for 14 days.

**Stay at home:**

- **Book a test for child who has symptoms** (online is best, <https://self-referral.test-for-coronavirus.service.gov.uk/antigen/name>)
- Keep trying, entering information each time – easily up to 20x – often new slots released 0830, 0900 & 1000 – keep trying and get a postal test ordered as well if struggling to get on-site test booked.;
- Up to 4 family members can go in 1 car to be tested, if they have symptoms;
- Stay at home until test results received.

**Positive**

**Positive Covid Test =**

1. Child must stay at home for 10 days;
2. Ring school immediately 01344 772034;
3. Family members must self isolate for 14 days.

- ✓ Keep your child off school – call school absence line 01344 772034 & leave a message with reason for absence.
- ✓ 48hrs off for sickness and diarrhoea
